CRC RECREATIONAL SPRING SEASON

U9 – U15 BOYS & GIRLS

The spring season is for players to participate, develop, and have fun. Playing time is fairly equal and coaches follow these guidelines and may make adjustments due to injury, fitness, practice and game attendance, etc. Home games and practices are at the "Fields for Kids". Away games are played around the Coulee Region. Players are placed on gender specific teams by the club.

Season: Early April (weather depending) to end of May - 2 practices weekly and 2 games per weekend

Registration Fee: U9 – U12: \$85 per player U13 – U15: \$125 per player

Tournaments: Teams play in the CRC Tournament – June 4 – 6, 2010 at our 'Fields For Kids'. This is included in your registration fee. Other tournaments entered are at the discretion and expense of the individual team.

MYSA COMPETITIVE SUMMER LEAGUE

U11 – U18 BOYS & GIRLS

Playing in Minnesota & Wisconsin, home games are played at the 'Fields For Kids' and most away games are played in communities to the south of the Minneapolis-St. Paul metropolitan area.

Season: Early May to late July

Games: Approximately 10 weeknight games (5 home – 5 away)

Team Practices: 2 - 3 practices per week (starting mid-April)

Registration Fee: \$275 per player

Uniforms: \$60 - includes home & away jersey, shorts and socks (not included in the registration fee)

Tournaments: Included in registration are a maximum of 3 tournaments of their choice. If a team chooses not to participate, there are no refunds

Playoffs: Team registration fees included for MYSA District and State Tournament Play

REFUNDABLE VOLUNTEER FEE

The mandatory \$50 Volunteer Fee (refundable) is per family, not per player, and is **NOT** included in the Registration Fees above. It must be submitted in addition to your program registration fee. Each family must complete 8 hours of volunteer work to be eligible to receive their Volunteer Fee refund.
